Procedure Statement

Student societies, clubs, living groups, and other student organizations, on or off campus, are responsible for conducting their affairs in a manner that reflects favorably upon the university.

Reason for Procedure

Responsibilities of these groups and consequences of failing to accept the responsibilities are outlined in this procedure.

Procedures and Responsibilities

1. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1.1 Compliance with university rules and procedures.
- 1.2 Taking reasonable steps, as a group, to prevent violations of law or university regulations by members of the group or guests.
- 1.3 A willingness to deal individually with those members of the group whose behavior reflects unfavorably upon the university.

2. FAILURE TO ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 Failure to accept the responsibilities of group membership may subject that organization to the following:
 - 2.1.1 Permanent or temporary suspension of charter.
 - 2.1.2 Withdrawal of university recognition and/or support.
 - 2.1.3 Social probation.
 - 2.1.4 Denial of use of university facilities or other appropriate action.

3. APPEAL

- 3.1 Any appeal from action by the Dean of Campus Life and Student Development that affects organizational status only (i.e., no sanctions against individuals) shall be directed to the Vice President for Student Access and Success.
