

Tenure-Track Assistant Professor

The Department of Physics and Astronomy at A&M Commerce University in Commerce, Texas, invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professor position. The position will begin around August 16, 2012, and is contingent upon the availability of funds. A PhD in Physics, Astronomy or a closely related field is required. The primary responsibility is to direct K-12 teacher preparation courses in the physical sciences. The successful applicant should have exceptional teaching skills, and a strong interest in teacher preparation. Preference will be given to candidates with an interest in education research or research areas that complement existing department strengths, and to candidates with strong interest or demonstrated experience in teacher education. Post-doctoral experience and the potential for attracting external funding are desirable.
