

Texas A&M University-Commerce Dissertation/Theses Guidelines for Use of Copyrighted Materials

If you are using material(s) that is copyrighted, you must determine if you need to obtain permission from the author to use the material(s). You must acquire written permission from the author if you use any of the following.

1. Quotations that are more than one and one-half single-spaced pages.
2. Copied material in the same form that it was originally used, i.e. instruments, articles, questionnaires.
3. Complete poems, even if the work is brief.
4. Music; dialogue from a novel, broadcast, play or screenplay; pictorial works or graphics.

"Fair use" is sometimes unclear, if there is a question of infringement, secure the author's permission.
